## Place Value Yahtzee

## Materials:

- Place Value Yahtzee score cards (download at https://cdn.shopify.com/s/files/l/0955/2452/files/Place_Value_Yahtzee_Scor e_Cards.pdf? 7660609586503075550)
- Dice (the number of dice needed depends on the game level being used)
- 3-digit numbers $=3$ dice
- 4-digit numbers $=4$ dice
- 6-digit numbers $=6$ dice
- Decimal numbers $=5$ dice
- Cup for holding the dice
- Pencils


## Directions:

1. A player rolls the dice ( $3,4,5$, or 6 dice are used depending on the level of the player). The dice are shaken from a cup onto the table.
2. After the first roll, a player decides to keep what $\mathrm{s} /$ he has rolled or reroll some or all of the dice.
3. After the second roll, the score card is filled in using the numbers that have been rolled.
4. A player fills in only one space at a time on the score card.
5. The next player begins their turn.
6. The game continues until the nine spaces on the score card are filled in with a number.

A point is given for each category on the score sheet that is filled in correctly. The player with the largest number in a category receives another point. The player with the highest score wins.
